Following the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, the UK government has decided that the Summer 2021 examination series will not go ahead as planned. Instead, teachers will determine student grades, based upon a range of evidence verified by schools. These results will then be reviewed by the exam boards who designed each course, before awarding the final grades which reflect your performance on content you have been taught, and allow you to confidently progress to the next stage of your education or into employment.

Teachers will initially determine your grades, which will then be reviewed by our school and moderated by colleagues from local secondary schools. Our judgement will only be based on what you have been taught and we will use a range of evidence from across the course of study to make our decision, including: Records of your performance on the content you have been taught over the entire course of your studies, non-exam assessment, classwork, homework, internal tests, mock exams and past papers.

LEEP teaching staff inform our students which pieces of work will be used as evidence to inform their overall grade. No single piece of evidence will necessarily be more important than another, as teachers will be assessing students based on a range of evidence that can give an overall picture of their performance. This is why it is imperative that they attend each day and complete the work they are given as we are still in the process of gathering evidence. Once all the evidence is selected and assessments are complete, teachers will decide on an overall grade. They will do this objectively – so, if you are performing consistently at a level 4 standard in a subject at GCSE, you should be awarded a level 4.

We will not be able to tell you/students the grade we have submitted to the exam board. GCSE students will receive their results from LEEP on Thursday 12 August 2021 between 10:00 am to 12:00pm. If a student is unavailable to collect their results and wants someone else to collect them on their behalf (e.g. a family member), an authorisation email must be sent to [j.wells@leep.org.uk](mailto:j.wells@leep.org.uk) before Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021 providing details of whom the collector is. **No results will be distributed via telephone or email under any circumstances.**

For any results that are not collected on results day the student will receive written notification via 1<sup>st</sup> class post. Results will be posted out to the student's home address.

Should a student have a discrepancy with regards to any of their exam results, please contact the exam office on the email above. The exam officer will advise of the official procedure to follow for enquiries about results.
